Article looking at various fabrics and how well they filter. Lead author is Lindsay Marr a big researcher in this field. For the graphs, look at the red and blue lines (inward and outward efficiency) and see how well they perform for the 0.5-1um sized particles. Most of the cloths were around 25% efficiency. My fit tested N99 respirator would have achieved 99.5% efficiency in that size range. https://www.medrxiv.org/content/10.1101/2020.11.18.20233353v1.full.pdf
