#### PRO Grants Discussion

- Elmdale is doing the virtual Scientists in the Classroom for 30 families.
- Melody registration was difficult, last year was easier
  - Would like more communication, just the one email with lacking details needed to organize effectively
  - Looking to connect with science in the schools
- Katimavik Ralph
  - o Got the first email, turse but to the point
  - Not much uptake to champion to do own thing and so did speaker



- Discussing the kit distribution think can have a box at the school parents can p.u. Need to consider and work around the no parents at the school yet which difficult to coordinate things.
- o Promotion is through newsletter and email
- o Paired with Castle Frank and open it up if do not have enough uptake
- Would have really liked more time to choose. Felt really limited with time and those that made the decision, just too few making the choice
- Why does this have to be for each school but instead be open to all?
   Because it's virtual could be more open to have choice other than that the council choice. As caregiver interested in other topics that was chosen by council.
- South March (Paul Davis) and Jack Donohue (Parents 4 Diversity) also partnered and are sharing open spots. Registration timing was issue.
- Sarah is doing COUNCIL choice
  - o Polled parents based on last year's topics way in advance but disappointed with options this year. School already does SIS, Timing is not great as school is younger grades and evening is too late. Felt it was largely geared to older and that not much offering for them. Most Kinder do not use tech same way. Nothing for mindfulness and families.
  - o Partnering with other school is being investigated
  - Registration was difficult, received a simple confirmation only and then toolkit but not clear ie. as to how the funds will be handled.
  - Turn around felt really rushed
  - o Would like more support with own choice option
- Vimy Ridge Math Guru and teamed up another school
- What about not doing PRO?
  - o Earl of March not because of timing. No opportunity to really consult.
